Typical Products Packaged in Various Paperboard Types

Paperboard Package Type	Typical Products Packaged
Aseptic packaging	Shelf stable milk and juices, soups
Beverage carrier	Beer and soda
Blister pack cards	Products enclosed beneath a thermoformed clear plastic held in place by paperboard
Composite can	Frozen concentrated juices
Folding cartons	Any boxed product; auto parts, food, toys, cosmetics, soap, pet food
Headers	Holding plastic pouches on peg display
Liquid packaging (gable top cartons)	Milk and juice
Ovenable paperboard	Microwaveable and ovenable frozen foods
Sanitary food containers	Chinese take out
Set-up boxes	Jewelry and candy boxes
Skin pack cards	Products enclosed under shrink film on a paperboard backing
